I hope this letter finds that you are in good health and successfully surviving the Holiday concert season! Thank you for your continued support of the New England Solo & Ensemble Festival.

The results from this year's adjudications can now be found through the online site linked on the Solo & Ensemble Results page of www.nemfa.org. You will need the NEMFA ID you created during registration to access your students' information, including adjudication forms, ratings and possible ensemble selection and seating. The following week, you will also find a complete ensemble roster for the New England Concert Festival on March 17th thru March 19th in Burlington, Connecticut. Rehearsals and the performance will be at Lewis S. Mills High School, 26 Lyon Rd., Burlington, CT 06013.

The Chorus music will be mailed to the sponsor and the Band and Orchestra music will be available electronically via a shared Google folder. You will need to confirm the participation of each of your students and have them complete their Student Contract by **January 21, 2022**. Once done, please print out the Acceptance Form/Invoice, provide the proper signatures and send with the amount shown. The student fee for the **2022 Concert Festival is \$150.00**. Those Acceptance Form/Invoices and payment or **proof of payment** needs to be postmarked by **January 21, 2022** and sent to:

As you know one special feature of the New England Concert Festival is that students are housed in local host families' homes. This year, due to COV-ID, we will be using hotel stays for the first time ever. This cost is reflected in the Concert Festival Fee. When we get closer to the festival you will be sent your housing information. Please let us know if your school has a different policy for students rooming with students from other schools on the acceptance form.

If your online information is incomplete or your Acceptance Form / Invoice & payment/proof of payment is not postmarked by **January 21, 2022**, you will incur a \$100 late fee. After **February 1, 2022**, the ensemble managers will begin filling the spots made available by incomplete participation information, non-received payments and by students declining their selection.
